Medium close up of an TOOTHY Sr. upper torso sleeping on his bed. On the side table beside the bed, a pair of dino dentures are in a glass of water. Toothy's hand can be seen coming from off panel ready to snatch the teeth from their table.

2. TOOTHY SR. (SFX)
Snore.

3. SFX
Snatch.

PANEL 3

This is the same shot as panel 1 but with the T-Rex Sr.'s dentures in his mouth. The teeth are human rather than T-Rex (so no sharp teeth. Think The Mask comic). Toothy is roaring again at the small rodent but this time the wee creature is jumping up in the air with fright.
