The following four panels should be of equal width and height. The the only movement between the scenes will be between the characters and a clock.

PANEL 1

In this panel we see a medium shot of a FATHER cradling his infant SON in his left arm whilst his right arm holds a bottle of milk that is getting drunk by the Son. The Father is sitting on a simple chair on the right of the panel. An analogue clock on the wall to the left reads five minutes past four. The milk bottle is full.

PANEL 2

The same panel as before. The father has shifted his position in the seat to be more comfortable. The milk bottle is now three quarters full and the clock now reads twenty minutes past four.

PANEL 3

Again this panel is pretty similar as the ones before. The father has once again shifted positions. The milk bottle is now half full and clock reads twenty to five.

PANEL 4

Final panel the Father has now taking the bottle away from the Sons mouth only to find the bottle has not gone down since the last panel. The time reads five o'clock on the clock.
